

Dear Parents/Carer

Welcome back to school for the Summer Term.

Our topic for this term is Journeys. The children will learn about Space and other journeys.

MATHEMATICS.

We will be working on measures, shape and space, counting in 3's and 4's and data handling, together with revising the strategies for the four rules (+, -, \times , \div). Throughout the term we will be focusing on using and applying mathematical skills as well as recalling number bonds.

LITERACY.

In literacy we will be studying stories by famous authors, looking at different books written by the same author and extended stories by one author, for example Roald Dahl or Dick King-Smith. We will be looking at information texts about space and retrieving information and using contents and glossary pages effectively. The children will also be looking at riddles and tongue twisters.

Please try to read with your child and talk to them about the information they have learnt from the book. This is one of the best ways to support their learning.

Also during the term (16th, 17th, 18th June) we have arranged a visit to Redbridge Museum to look at the change in the local area by studying maps and photographs. We will also use this trip to enable the children to record a journey.

This term is also when Year 2 children complete their SAT's. These will be completed during May and the results given to you along with their school report in July. Please speak to their class teacher or myself if you have any queries about the SAT's.

During the term the children will begin to make visits to the junior school in preparation for September.

The children will be very busy again this term and we will finish the term with a Sports Day and concert.

We hope this information will be useful in helping you to support your child's learning in school.
